<sup>1</sup>When the LORD restored the fortunes of Zion,  
we were like those who dream.

<sup>2</sup>Then our mouth was filled with laughter,  
and our tongue with shouts of joy;  
then they said among the nations,  
“The LORD has done great things for them.”

<sup>3</sup>The LORD has done great things for us;  
we are glad.

<sup>4</sup>Restore our fortunes, O LORD,  
Like streams in the Negeb!

<sup>5</sup>Those who sow in tears  
shall reap with shouts of joy!

<sup>6</sup>He who goes out weeping,  
bearing the seed for sowing,  
shall come with shouts of joy,  
bringing his sheaves with him.

### Discussion Questions:
